**SUBJECT:** Proposed Fringe Benefit Rates – FY 2023

The University recently submitted its Fringe Benefit Rate proposal to the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) for fiscal year 2023. These rates should be utilized as the best estimates available in submitting FY 2023 budget and grant proposals. As you are aware, one set of rates is applicable to sponsored research funds (Entity 05) from federally funded sources and one for all other funds (e.g. Entity 02, 03, 04, and non-federally funded sponsored research in Entity 05). Please note that only the rates applicable to federally funded sponsored research are subject to DHHS approval. The proposed fringe benefit rates for FY 2023 are as follows:

**FOR FEDERALLY FUNDED SPONSORED RESEARCH (ENTITY 05 ONLY):**
